You are invited to take part in a research study being conducted by Dr. XXXX in conjunction with the Centre for Experimental Social Sciences. In concordance with CESS policy, today's study has received approval of its ethicality from CESS's independent review board.

We ask that you read this form carefully prior to deciding whether to participate in today's study. If you decide you do not want to participate, you may leave at any time without providing a reason and without penalty. If you choose to leave prior to the completion of the study, you will still receive £5 for coming to today's session.

Purpose: The purpose of this study is to examine how people make decisions under various monetary incentives.

What Happens During the Study: The study requires you to sit in front of a computer terminal and make a series of decisions that may affect your final earnings and the final earnings of others. After the main part of your experiment, you will be asked to answer some survey questions about your personal characteristics and opinions.

Participation: The study is expected to take up to XXXX hours and you will be paid your earnings, in cash, at its conclusion. You always have the option of stopping your participation in today's project and you may leave at any time without providing a reason and without penalty. If your behaviour is disruptive, you may be asked to leave. If you leave prior to the completion of the study, you will still receive £5 for coming to today's session.

Potential Risks: Participation in today's study poses minimal risk. None of the risks are greater than those encountered in daily life.

Benefits: Beyond the compensation you will receive for your participation today, you are aiding the further development of science.

Compensation: You will receive a minimum of £5 for coming to today's study. This amount will be given to you independent of your decision to participate in today's study. You can earn considerable more during the course of the study. Your final earnings may be determined by your decisions, the decisions of others and luck. Although we cannot tell you exactly how much you will earn for your participation today, CESS participants historically earn an additional £10 per hour spent in the lab.

Data Protection and Privacy:

After you sign this consent form, the experimenter will give you an ID number for the experiment, and that is the way in which you are identified in the experiment. You will finally be paid in private according to your ID number. The only place where your name appears is on this consent form and the receipt that you will sign at the conclusion of the study. No information about you provided by you during this research will be disclosed to others without your written permission, except:

- if necessary to protect your rights or welfare (for example, if you are injured and need emergency care); or
- if required by law.

The information collected during the study will be kept private. In concordance with the Data Protection Act of 1998 & 2018, the University of Oxford is the data controller. Responsible members of the University of Oxford and funders may be given access to data for monitoring and/or audit of the study to ensure we are complying with guidelines or as otherwise required by law.

The original data will be made anonymous and then stored on CESS's secure server that is only accessible by members of CESS. No one other than members of CESS or responsible members of the University of Oxford will have access to any records of this experiment, and none of the records will identify you using any personal information. The data will be stored in electronic form, password protected. All physical identifying information will be stored in a locked secure location. A copy of the anonymized data will be provided to the primary investigator listed at the top of this form. The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored and processed at, a destination outside the United Kingdom. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing, and processing. Your individual privacy will be maintained in all publications or presentations resulting from this study.
